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This paper presents an interesting new data set that, as expressed in the paper, offers the potential for extensive change detection.

The main issue with the paper is it's unclear exactly how the margins were mapped: manually? brightness threshold? This needs to be explained more clearly.

Another issue is availability of the data itself. Is this data available? It seems strange to have a paper presenting a private data set.

Some examples, in another figure or incorporated into Figure 2, of the aerial imagery used would be helpful.

In figure 1 it's not clear what we're looking - what is this a map of?
