AUTHORS: We now use ‘because of’ (line 121).

**P9L25 ‘out’ should be ‘our’**

**P14L4 ‘annul’ should be ‘annual’**

AUTHORS: We have corrected these two typographic errors (lines 217, 325).

**P14L8 ‘simply’ should be ‘simplify’**

AUTHORS: We delete the entire sentence. Instead of using a simplified constant geometry, we now use site-wise incidence angles and slopes to convert InSAR line-of-sight displacement to downslope displacement (lines 222-224).
