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Dear Antoine and co-authors

I am sorry that it has taken so long to obtain reviews for this paper, but glad that we now have two thorough and constructive reviews. There may be a third on the way, but for now I suggest we start to move forward.

It is clear from the reviews that substantial revision of the manuscript will be needed before it can be accepted for publication, so I encourage you to start work on this now. Changes will need to be made to the overall structure of the presentation, as recommended by R2, and also to the details of the scientific argument (as suggested by R1). If comments come in from R3, then I will contact you again with advice as to

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how to deal with those.

At this point I cannot guarantee that the paper will be accepted for publication after revision, and it is possible that I will seek further advice from the reviewers on whether the revised manuscript is publishable. Nonetheless I hope that you will persist with the revisions and we can reach a point where the work can be published in The Cryosphere.
