

Interactive comment on “Nationwide aerial laser scanning reveals relict rock glaciers and protalus ramparts in Slovenia” by Mihaela Triglav-Čekada et al.

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Dear Dr. Triglav-Cekada,

I have carefully read both reviews and it seems that we received an unambiguous feedback from two reviewers that your paper contains an interesting inventory of relict rock glaciers and protalus ramparts in an underresearched Part of the Alps, but both reviewers state that the scientific novelty, the methodologic innovation and the general outcome of the paper are not sufficient for such a high-impact journal such as “The Cryosphere”. However, both reviewers provide numerous general and specific comments that will help to revise the paper and redraft a significantly improved version of the manuscript. I still doubt that The Cryosphere, targeting cutting edge developments

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and research, would be the appropriate journal for this revised paper but you could certainly try a more geomorphologically-orientated journal if the general conclusion are well-developed at this stage.
