The authors provide a well-written and superbly illustrated treatise on the Coats Land margin strongly supported by a suite of geophysical and geological evidence. The authors are to be congratulated on crafting a robust sequence of regionally significant geological events, given the challenge of the sheer size of the study area, and its seafloor complexity and spectrum of onshore–offshore linkages. Thus, this manuscript deserves publication with only minor edits.
